- Support the school's guidelines and policies for behaviour and E-Safety;
- Support our/my child in all opportunities for home learning;
- Attend parents' evenings and discussions about our/my child's progress;
- Get to know our/my child's life in school;
- Read and act on any information sent home.

The school will endeavour to:

- Contact parents if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality, equipment or uniform;
- Let parents know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviour;
- Provide information to parents on the progress made by their child and arrange any parent/teacher meetings to this end;
- Provide home learning activities for the child to complete at home with parental support;
- Keep parents informed about school activities through regular letters home, emails, newsletters and notices about special events and requests;
- Provide opportunities for parents to become involved with school life.

Each child will endeavour to keep the Buckland Primary School code:

- Attend school every day;
- Respect others, be friendly and behave in accordance with our school, classroom and playground rules;
- Work hard and do his/her BEST in classwork and home learning, including reading;
- Bring his/her book bag or Home/School diary to school each day;
- Bring his/her PE kit to school.
