# Colour



# This half term our topic in Reception will be colour.

We will be:

- Investigating Autumn and autumn colours.
- Looking at Bonfire Night.
- Hibernation.
- Exploring colour mixing.
- Watching DVDs and discussing how children celebrate different festivals.
- Talking about and making things for Christmas.



## Maths

**Week 1** Recognising and ordering numbers to 10 or 20 and beyond. Counting out the correct number of objects up to 20.

**Week 2** Looking at money in real life situations.

**Week 3** One more or less than numbers to 5, 10 or 20 or beyond.

**Week 4** Addition using real life problems. For example there were 5 people on the bus and 2 more got on. How many people are on the bus.?

**Week 5** Subtraction using real life problems. There were 6 people on the bus. It stopped and 1 person got off. How many people are left on the bus?

**Week 6** Looking at size and using the correct language. Ordering tall and short and long and short.

**Week 7** Shapes. Looking at shapes all around them. Making shape biscuits.

**Week 8** Pattern. Looking at patterns on Christmas wrapping paper. Make party hats and crackers using different shapes.
