

Change



The learning in this topic is broken down into weekly themes as follows:-

Week 1: How we change

Week 2: Butterflies

Week 3: Camouflage

Week 4: Plants

Week 5: Frogs

Week 6: Ducklings



This is a largely science-based topic in which we shall be looking at change in a variety of contexts, such as:-

Growth of plants and animals (including the life cycle of the frog , duck and the butterfly).

Freezing and melting water.

Changes caused by cooking.

Colour change and camouflage in nature.



Maths

Week 1 Count reliably up to 20 and beyond. Recognise and order numbers to 10. Order a set of random numbers.

Find 1 more or less than a number up to 10. Say which number is bigger or small / more or less.

Week 2 Addition: Real life addition problems. Use a number line to show addition. Find doubles up to double 10. Number bonds for 5 and 10.

Week 3 Subtraction: Sharing a group of objects into 2. Real life problems involving subtraction. Finding half by sharing. Subtracting facts for 5 and 10.

Week 4 Look at pattern including symmetrical patterns.

Week 5 Time: days of the week / months of the year / o'clock. Look at 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

Reading/Phonics

Please continue to change your child's book every day and spend 10 minutes reading and going over words and sounds.

We have now finished the Jolly Phonics sounds. Please keep practising the letter sounds and actions at home, particularly the two letter combinations (digraphs), such as ie., er, ar etc.
